Type	Plant image	Plant description	Number
Shrubs to 6m and trees		Acacia rubida Red-stemmed Wattle Shrub or small tree to 4m - attractive reddish stems - red ferny juvenile foliage changing to long grey-green phyllodes - pale yellow flowers in Spring - frost hardy.	
		Eucalyptus camaldulensis River Red Gum Magnificent spreading tree reaching 30m - pendulous bluish foliage and smooth white & grey trunk - hardy to frost and poorly drained soils.	
		Eucalyptus sideroxylon Mugga Ironbark A hardy tree growing to 20m tall - rugged black bark - pendulous grey-green foliage - pink flowers Spring & Autumn – tolerant of clay – frost hardy.	
		Grevillea Poorinda Peter Very hardy and vigorous shrub growing 4m x 4m - deeply divided leaves with reddish new growth - red toothbrush flowers in Spring & Summer - frost hardy.	
		Hakea salicifolia fine leaf form Hardy fast growing large shrub or small tree to 8m tall - attractive foliage with reddish growth tips - axillary clusters of white flowers in Spring - useful screening plant or street tree - frost hardy.

Shrubs to 3m		Callistemon pungens Hardy shrub to 3m - broad dark green leaves with silvery new growth - purple brushes in Spring - frost hardy.	
		Grevillea endlicheriana Tall, rounded shrub to 3m tall - long narrow bluish green leaves - tall flowering canes bearing clusters of tiny white flowers in Winter - moderate frost tolerance.	
		Callistemon Horse Paddock Compact shrub growing 2m high - broad green leaves with showy red new growth - bright red brushes occur in Spring - requires minimal pruning - tolerant of moderate frost.	
		Eremophila maculata aurea Spreading shrub to 1.5m high by 2m wide - narrow dark green leaves - clear yellow tubular flowers over a long period - frost hardy.	
		Eremophila Summertime Blue Spreading shrub to 1.5m - narrow, shiny, green leaves - showy mauve/blue flowers in Spring, Summer & Autumn - tolerant of lime, frost and part shade.	
		Grevillea Big Red Shrub to 2m tall x 2m wide, small oval deep green leaves – orange/red spider flowers during Winter and Spring – frost hardy.	
		Grevillea Burgundy Beauty Fast growing screening shrub to 2m tall by 3m wide - light green fern like leaves - burgundy toothbrush flowers occur throughout the year - tolerates frost & wind.	
		Isopogon Pink Drumsticks An upright shrub to 2m tall - long green leaves - pink drumstick flowers occur in Winter & Spring - moderate frost tolerance - useful cut flower.	
		Prostanthera phyllifolia Mint bush - erect bushy shrub to 1.5m - small dark green aromatic leaves - purple bell-shaped flowers in Spring - frost hardy.

Low shrubs to 1m and ground covers		Brachyscome Amethyst Small, rounded perennial, ideal for borders and pots – green divided leaves – brilliant magenta daisies are produced most of the year – moderate frosts only.	
		Darwinia citriodora A hardy attractive shrub growing to 1m - succulent looking lemon scented foliage; turns a reddish colour in Winter - small, unusual orange flowers during Spring - moderate frosts only.	
		Eremophila Pink Passion A compact shrub to 1m tall suitable for hedging - lush green foliage - prolific bright pink flowers for most of the year - tolerant of extended dry periods & frost hardy.	
		Grevillea Carpet Queen Dainty prostrate plant - small pointed green leaves - apricot orange spider flowers in Winter, Spring and Summer - frost hardy.	
		Grevillea Hills Jubilee Compact shrub growing 1m tall x 1m wide - small narrow linear leaves - clusters of waxy pink & white flowers throughout the year - tolerant of heavy clay – frost hardy.	
		Homoranthus papillatus A neat compact shrub to 0.50m x 1.0m - unusual horizontally spreading branches of grey foliage - tiny yellow honey rich flowers on the tops of the branches in Spring - frost hardy.	
		Prostanthera teretifolia Rare shrub from the Torrington & Stanthorpe districts reaching 1m tall - strongly aromatic soft grey foliage - purple flowers during Spring - requires a well-drained situation - frost hardy.	
		Thelionema caespitosum blue A native lily with tufted grass like leaves growing to 30 cm tall - bears blue star like flowers on stems to 50 cm tall - frost hardy.	
		Wahlenbergia communis Snowbells Perennial forb with a diameter of 20 cm - suckering green foliage - prolific five petalled white "blue bells" occur on slender stems most of the year - frost hardy.
