CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All entries must be recent (within 2 years) and be the original, unaided work of the exhibitor, (not copied) and not previously exhibited in a Stanthorpe Show or winner in another competition. No work may be entered in more than one class.
- 2. Works in all classes must be ready for hanging PLEASE ensure secure hanging devices include D rings with wire or hanging cord etc. Stewards reserve the right to reject any work not ready for hanging.
- 3. Each work must have: Artist Name, Address, Contact Phone Number and Email, title of work, class, medium, and sale price or NFS (not for sale).
- 4. Work must not be more than 90cm x 60cm in size and photographs and digitally enhanced work are not acceptable.
- 5. No more than 3 entries maximum per artist.
- 6. 25% commission on sales is payable to the Stanthorpe Agricultural Society.
- 7. The judge's decision is final; if the standard of work in any class is deemed to be insufficient, the judge may not award all prizes.
- 8. Entry into the competition conveys the right for images and details of artwork to be reproduced in the press and electronic media during the exhibition and in future promotional material for the Stanthorpe Show.
- 9. The exhibitor or their agent must sign for all artwork upon collection; no responsibility is accepted for uncollected works.
