SCRATCHING

- A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program.
- If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee.
- If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted.
- Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

SAFETY

- Competitors compete at their own risk subject to ACA and Stanthorpe Agricultural Society terms and conditions.
- While not compulsory, our committee encourages all riders to wear safety helmets while mounted.
- All riders under 18 years of age must wear an Australian Standard approved safety helmet whilst mounted in accordance with Rule B.5e of the ACA Rules.
- When worn, helmets must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules.

COVID RESTRICTIONS

The 2022 Stanthorpe Show campdraft will be run in conjunction with any COVID-19 requirements applicable at the time. As a minimum patrons must follow these rules:

- Do not come to the Stanthorpe Show campdraft if you are feeling unwell or exhibiting symptoms similar to COVID-19.
- WRISTBAND SYSTEM APPLIES: These will be supplied at the Club Road gate upon arrival. No entry will be permitted without complying to Qld Health requirements. NO WRISTBAND, NO RIDE.
- Adhere to physical distancing requirements i.e. remain 1.5m apart from people not from your same household.
- Wear masks if you cannot adhere to the physical distancing requirement.
- Sanitise hands frequently.
- If you have your own amenities in your float/truck, please use them.
- Take food and drink away from the catering area.
- Adhere to maximum capacity signs when entering buildings.
- Leave the showgrounds if you feel unwell throughout the day or start to exhibit symptoms similar to COVID-19.

HORSE HEALTH

- Competitors to ensure that their horse/s are of sound health and not showing any symptoms of illness or disease.
- In accordance with QCAS regulations for hosting the draft at a QCAS showgrounds, a completed horse health declaration (with PIC number) is required to be completed and submitted before your entry will be accepted.
- Stanthorpe Showgrounds PIC # is QKST 0814.
- The procedure is:
 - 1. Download the horse health declaration from the Stanthorpe Campdraft or ACA website.
 - 2. Complete it in full and copy it. A PIC number for the property of origin is required.
 - 3. Keep one copy with you while your horses are travelling.
 - 4. Bring a second copy to the campdraft office before you ride. No Horse Health Declaration = No Ride.
- If required during the draft, the quarantine area for horses at the showgrounds is the sheep dog trials arena in the north-west corner of the grounds.

STATUS

- The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Futurity, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts.
- The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).

CAMPING

- Camping available with full amenities.
- Please be mindful of other competitors when parking.

COMPLAINTS

- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place.
- A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
