## SHRUBS TO 6M AND TREES

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	<i>Banksia marginata</i> - Silver banksia Tree to 10m tall - oblong leaves, green above and silvery below - yellow flower spikes - enjoys moist but well drained conditions - frost hardy.	
	<i>Eremophila bignoniiflora x polyclada</i> Hardy shrub for a dry spot reaching 4m high - long narrow leaves - prolific large mauve tubular flowers much of the year - tolerant heavy soils – frost hardy.	
	<i>Eucalyptus pulverulenta</i> – Silver dollar gum Small shrubby tree to 4m with a ribbony white bark - round silver foliage suitable for floral work – cream gum blossom in Spring – may be pruned hard to encourage new growth - tolerates clay soils and is frost hardy.	
	<i>Eucalyptus sideroxylon</i> - Mugga ironbark An ornamental tree growing to 20m tall - pendulous grey-green foliage - pink flowers Spring and Autumn – tolerant of dry clay soils and is frost hardy.	




## SHRUBS TO 6M AND TREES (cont'd)

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	<i>Eucalyptus tereticornis</i> - Forest red gum Stately tree to 30m with a smooth bluish trunk and white flowers in Winter and Spring - tolerant of poorly drained, saline soils – frost hardy - durable timber - koala tree.	
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp. Elegance Big bushy shrub to 4m high - long finely divided dark green leaves - large erect spikes of waxy pink flowers occur Wi - Su - tolerant of drought – moderately frost hardy.	







## SHRUBS 1M-3M

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	<i>Callistemon citrinus</i> Endeavour Shrub to 3m - stiff dark green foliage with pink new growth - large crimson brushes in Spring and Autumn – frost hardy.	
	<i>Callistemon</i> sp. Pink Alma Compact shrub growing 1.5m x 1.5m - oval green leaves with pink new growth - good display of mid pink brushes in Spring and again in Autumn - frost hardy.	
	<i>Callistemon ptyoides</i> (pink) Alpine Bottlebrush - shrub growing to 1.5m tall - very small green leaves - short pink brushes with yellow anthers occur in Spring - tolerant of wet conditions – frost hardy.	
	<i>Callistemon</i> sp. Purple splendour Hardy shrub to 2m - stiff dark green leaves - large showy purple bottlebrushes in Spring - frost hardy.	
	<i>Callistemon</i> sp. Bolivia pink Rare shrub from near Bolivia Hill south of Tenterfield growing to 3m tall - oval green leaves - bright pink brushes in summer - frost hardy.	
	<i>Chamelaucium</i> sp. Paddy's pink Bushy shrub growing 1.5m x 1.5m - fine grey green foliage - pink flowers shaped like cupped Geraldton Wax flowers are produced in Spring - suitable for cut flower production - tolerant of moderate frost.	
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp. Apricot charm Shrub to 2m high - small green oval leaves - apricot flower clusters in Spring - tolerant of heavier soils and is frost hardy.	
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp. Carol Ann Low growing hardy plant 2m in width - dense non prickly foliage with an occasional upward growing branch - dark red spider flowers over a long period - frost and drought hardy.	

## SHRUBS 1M-3M (cont'd)

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp. Red sunset This spreading shrub reaches only 2m x 3m - red spider flowers are produced in profusion in Winter and Spring - tolerates limy soil and is frost hardy.	
	<i>Hakea nodosa</i> Fast growing hardy hakea reaching 3m tall - slender arching branches of terete leaves – tiny fragrant yellow flowers in Autumn and Winter leaving interesting seed pods - frost hardy.	
	<i>Leionema beckleri</i> A neat, rounded shrub growing up to 1.5m tall - small green oval leaves - masses of white starry flowers from Winter to Summer - prefers some shade and a cool root run – frost hardy.	

## LOW SHRUBS TO 1M AND GROUND COVERS

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	<i>Brachyscome</i> sp. Fresco candy Colourful mounding groundcover growing 25cm high x 60cm wide for a cottage garden - deep green lobed leaves - large candy pink flowers in Spring, Summer and Autumn – light frost only.	
	<i>Casuarina</i> sp. 'Cousin it' Unusual ground cover capable of spreading to 3m wide - useful for growing over a wall - fine dark green foliage - tolerant of moderate frost.	
	<i>Correa alba</i> Western pink star Small shrub growing to 0.3m x 1m - oval felted green leaves - pale pink starlike flowers fading to white - frost hardy.	
	<i>Correa</i> sp. Cardinal bells Compact shrub to 1m high - bright green foliage - masses of large orange/red bells in Autumn - frost hardy.	
	<i>Correa</i> sp. Country belle Upright shrub to 1.5m tall - dark green felted oval leaves - this shrub is showy with green tipped red bells during the Autumn months – frost hardy.	
	<i>Eremophila debilis</i> Prostrate ground cover - green foliage turning purplish in Winter - mauve flowers in Spring, Autumn and Summer followed by edible cream and purple berries - tolerates dryness and is frost hardy.	

## LOW SHRUBS TO 1M AND GROUND COVERS (cont'd)

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	<i>Eremophila maculata</i> cerise – Spotted emu bush Shrub to 1m - spotted cerise tubular flowers much of the year - tolerates drought and limy soils and is frost hardy.	
	<i>Gastrolobium</i> sp. Brown butterfly Groundcover to 0.5m high x 3.0m across - great for growing on retaining walls as it appreciates good drainage - unusual brown leaves with a green edge - red pea flowers in Summer - grows in sun or part shade and tolerates light frost.	
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp. Billy wing Shrub to 1m tall - soft grey foliage with linear leaves - waxy red spider flowers in Winter and Spring - frost and drought hardy.	
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp. Winter delight Hardy groundcover reaching 30 cm tall x 1.5m across - soft grey linear leaves - showy red and cream flowers in Winter and Spring - frost hardy.	
	<i>Myoporum parvifolium</i> (fine leaf pink) Prostrate groundcover with a diameter of 2m - small fleshy green leaves - pale pink starry flowers - moist position - frost hardy.	
	<i>Philotheca</i> sp. Flower girl Hardy shrub to 1m suitable for rockery or tub specimen - aromatic green leaves - pink buds opening to pale pink starry flowers in Winter and Spring – frost hardy.	
	<i>Philotheca myoporoides</i> subsp. <i>acuta</i> Hardy shrub to 1.5m tall - small green aromatic leaves - pink buds followed by starry white flowers in Spring - frost hardy.	
	<i>Prostanthera</i> sp. Mauve mantle While this vigorous shrub will grow to only 1m tall, it will reach 3m in width - small dark green leaves - mauve flowers with purple spotted throat during Spring - tolerates filtered sun - frost hardy.	
	<i>Stenanthemum scortechinii</i> Pepper and salt A dense shapely shrub to 1m for rockery or container culture - small, pointed leaves - round woolly flower heads in Winter and Spring, ideal for picking and drying - frost hardy.	
	<i>Westringia</i> sp. Jervis gem This compact westringia grows to 1m high x 1m wide - grey/green foliage - lilac flowers most of the year - salt tolerant and frost hardy.
