- Crop load (except lettuce) 20 points.
- Crop health (pest and disease, weeds) 20 points.
- Adoption of technology 20 points.
- Uniformity of crop and paddock 20 points.
- Fruit/vegetable quality, colour and size (appropriate for variety), freedom from blemishes (hail damage not considered a blemish in the field) 20 points.
- TOTAL 100 points.

- Quality - freedom from disease, imperfections, etc. 20 points.
- Presentation - height and alignment in pack 20 points.
- Sizing and compactness 20 points.

TRAY EXHIBITS – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All varieties to be correctly named.
2. Exhibits to be in the hands of the Stewards by 12 noon, if possible, on Thursday prior to the show.
3. All exhibits to be grown by exhibitor.
4. All cartons to be branded for the market in conformity with state regulations.
5. Each competitor shall mark on the end of his/her carton or tray, the class and exhibit number and the steward will also tack on the top portion of the card supplied showing the class and exhibit no.
6. The judges have the privilege of using one or more fruits in any exhibit for cutting up etc. and will use their own discretion in the awarding of prizes.
7. Those exhibits approaching perfect uniformity of both size and form will have the best chance of obtaining maximum points awarded.
8. No unauthorized person will be allowed in the pavilion whilst judging is taking place.
