Will take place Wednesday 28/01/2026 at 6:00pm.

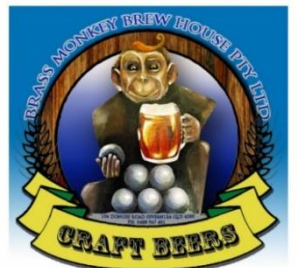
Awards presentation

Min. 200 grams.

Class 7302 Dried tomatoes

Any style, prepared for consumption.

Min. 150 grams.
