Exhibits to be entered on the general entry form. It is strongly advised that exhibitors read the schedule carefully as there are changes every year.

**Entry fees**

\$1.00 per item. Fees payable on delivery of your exhibits & entry form.

**Delivery of entries**

Entries to be received between 8:00am and 11:00am on Thurs 29/1/26.

\*PLEASE NOTE: As all stewards give their time voluntarily it is appreciated if exhibitors would assist by delivering their entries on time. Late entries may not be accepted.

**Judging**

Judging will take place from 11am on 29/1/26. This is not open to the public.

**Prize money**

1st \$5.00, 2nd \$3.00 unless otherwise shown. Prizes will be paid by cash, vouchers or books in line both with sponsors wishes and as determined by the Cookery subcommittee.

**Collection of Entries**

Entries and prizes to be collected only between 9:00am – 11:30am on Sunday 1/2/26.

Gate admission fees apply on Friday & Saturday. Stanthorpe Agricultural Society members free.

# **Conditions of Entry**

## **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY - IMPORTANT FOR ALL CLASSES**

1. One entry per person per class except “Any other variety” classes where multiple entries of different varieties are permitted.
2. Judges’ decisions are final, and judges reserve the right not to award prizes.
3. ROOKIE classes are for exhibitors who have not previously won a prize in that class in a Stanthorpe Show.
4. Prizes & exhibits are to be collected on SUNDAY 1/2/25 between 9.00am – 11.30am. Any exhibits not collected are disposed of after 12pm 1/2/25. If you cannot attend at this time, you must contact the Chief Steward before 12pm on 1/2/26 to make an alternative arrangement. Prizes & exhibits CANNOT be held at the Show Office under any circumstances.
5. Screw top jars to be at least 150gr. We advise opening your jars to break the seal and check the contents for mould before bringing them in. Jars with mould present or that cannot be opened will not be judged.
6. No wax on top, no fabric covers allowed, no decorations or other markings except a label showing the variety e.g. Strawberry Jam’. Ingredients do not have to be listed.
7. Jars to be clean, NOT sticky to touch, NO old labels.
8. Varieties must be named, no other marking allowed.
9. Uncollected prizes will be held by the Cookery subcommittee (see contact phone numbers above) and if not claimed within THREE MONTHS will become a donation to the Stanthorpe Agricultural Society. Prizes will not be mailed.
