## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. All breeders must supply a current Brucellosis Accredited Certificate.
2. All sheep must be bona fide property of a registered member of the Australian Stud Sheep Breeds Association and other Registered sheep Breed Societies.
3. All sheep must be free of external parasites.
4. NILS tags are required for all sheep.
5. Entries will only be received subject to the right of judge and steward, the judge or steward may reject stock which they may consider are not of sufficient merit to compete or are the wrong age of classes in which they are entered.
6. All sheep will be inspected prior to judging to ensure that they comply with the above regulations and conditions.
7. All sheep must be accompanied by a fully completed NVD or Waybill.
8. Entry cards which include tag numbers are to be completed and presented to the steward prior to judging.
9. All sheep to have a PIC number.
