## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## PLEASE READ CAREFULLY - IMPORTANT FOR ALL CLASSES

1. One entry per person per class except "Any other variety" classes where multiple entries of different varieties are permitted.
2. Judges' decisions are final and judges reserve the right not to award prizes.
3. ROOKIE classes are for exhibitors who have not previously won a prize in that class in a Stanthorpe Show.
4. Prizes \& exhibits are to be collected on SUNDAY 4/2/23 between 9.00am - 11.30am. Any exhibits not collected are disposed of after 12pm 4/2/23.
5. Screw top jars to be at least 150gr. We advise opening your jars to break the seal and check the contents for mould before bringing them in. Jars with mould present or that cannot be opened will not be judged.
6. No wax on top, no fabric covers allowed, no decorations or other markings except a label showing the variety e.g. 'Strawberry Jam'. Ingredients do not have to be listed.
7. Jars to be clean, NOT sticky to touch, NO old labels.
8. Varieties must be named, no other marking allowed.
