## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. No more than 2 entries in any class by one person.
2. Articles cannot be entered if they have been entered in any previous Stanthorpe Show.
3. Open Spinning – All skeins must state whether commercial or raw fleece & what purpose for yarn.
4. Novice Fibrecraft – Open to entrants who have not won a prize at Stanthorpe Show.

## **OPEN KNITTING & CROCHET**

Class 6101 Cardigan or jumper  
Made of hand spun wool

Class 6102 Sleeveless vest or cardigan  
Made of hand spun wool.

Class 6103 Cap, gloves, mitts or socks  
Made of hand spun wool.

Class 6104 Tricolour or more garment  
Made of hand spun wool, natural or dyed.

Class 6105 Garment  
Made from hand spun mixed fibres.

## **OPEN MISCELLANEOUS**

Class 6106 Scarf-free choice of technique  
Using hand spun fibre.

Class 6107 Any article using wool  
Not necessarily spun e.g. sheepskin.

Class 6108 Article or garment  
Hand spun natural fibre other than wool e.g. camel, silk, mohair, cotton, alpaca, ramee, linen.

Class 6109 Child's toy  
Made from natural fibre, may be dyed.

Class 6110 Child's garment up to 5 years  
Hand spun fibre any technique.

Class 6111 Stole or shawl  
In hand spun fibre any technique.

Class 6112 Any article wool  
Not necessarily spun, for example sheepskin.

Class 6113 Article or garment  
Which is the ORIGINAL DESIGN of the exhibitor, any technique using natural fibre and incorporating hand spun weaving, felting.

## **OPEN SPINNING**

**All skeins must state whether commercial or raw fleece & what purpose for yarn.**

Class 6114 Skein of hand spun wool

Suitable for delicate garment, free of grease, not less than 30gm.

Class 6115 Skein of hand spun wool

Equal to 5ply or more, free of grease, not less than 50gms, to be stated commercial or raw fleece.

Class 6116 Skein of novelty spun wool

Art yarn spun wool (unbalanced – thick & thin) not less than 30gm, state purpose.

Class 6117 1 Skein of hand spun fibre

Dyed with natural dyes, state materials and mordant used.

Class 6118 Skein of hand spun fibre

Other than wool, not less than 50gm.

Class 6119 Skein of hand spun mixed fibres

State not less than 50gm.

Class 6120 Skein of yarn

prepared and spun from raw fleece, should include a staple of fleece.

Class 6121 Any household article

Class 6122 One person's collection

3 different hand woven articles or garments using different techniques any looms, e.g. bag, tie, scarf etc.

Class 6123 Any hand-woven article or garment

Class 6124 Any hand-woven article or garment

Using any other fibres.
