SHRUBS TO 6M AND TREES

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	Acacia pendula 'Myall' A hardy slow growing shade tree to 18m, usually smaller - grey weeping foliage - cream flowers in Winter - tolerant of poorly drained soils - long lived - frost and drought hardy.	
	Callistemon sp. 'Happy Valley' Endemic to Stanthorpe, Qld, this erect shrub grows 4m tall - dark green oval leaves – flower spikes have pink stamens and red anthers, and occur in Spring - frost hardy.	
	Eucalyptus argophloia 'Chinchilla white gum' Stately white trunked tree to 25m - smooth weeping branches – white flowers in Summer - excellent timber - suited to poorly drained and clay soils - ideal for avenues - frost hardy.	
	Eucalyptus gunnii 'Cider gum' Fast growing tree to 25m - smooth green and white bark - round silver juvenile foliage changing to longer green leaves – foliage used in floral arrangements - tolerant of heavy wet soils - frost hardy.	
	Eucalyptus pauciflora 'Snow gum' Ornamental tree to 15m -smooth white trunk and glossy green leaves which glisten in the sun – profuse white flowers are produced in Spring and/or Summer - frost hardy.	

SHRUBS 1M-4M

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	Callistemon sp 'Great lakes' Hardy shrub to 3 m tall - pointed green leaves - showy plum red brushes in Spring - tolerant of frost and water logging.	
	Callistemon sp 'Mary MacKillop' Dense hardy shrub to 2.5m tall - weeping branches of soft green foliage - cardinal red bottlebrushes in flushes from Spring till Autumn – frost hardy.	
	Callistemon sp 'Mount Mistake' This hardy shrub grows to about 1.2m tall - pendulous grey green foliage - mid pink flowers with yellow anthers appear repeatedly during the warmer months - frost hardy.	
	Callistemon sp 'Pink champagne' Upright shrub to 3m tall x 2 m wide - attractive grey green foliage - pink brushes in flushes throughout the year - frost hardy.	
	Callistemon sp 'Prestige pink' A tidy rounded shrub growing to 2m tall - green foliage with reddish new growth - hot pink fading to soft pink brushes in Spring - frost hardy.	
	Callistemon pungens Hardy shrub to 3m - broad dark green leaves with silvery new growth - 6cm long purple brushes in Spring - frost hardy.	
	Calothamnus quadrifidus (grey form) 'Net bush' Shrub to 3m - upright branch spikes of downy grey foliage - brilliant red one-sided bottlebrush flowers in Spring – moderately frost hardy.	
	Correa sp 'Win's wonder' Dense spreading shrub growing 1m x 1.5m - attractive variegated foliage - rose pink tubular flowers in Autumn - enjoys morning sun - frost hardy.	
	Eremophila sp 'Fairy floss' A compact shrub growing to 2.2m tall by 2m wide - bright green foliage - yellow buds and pink flowers characterised by fine hairs protruding from the tube occur in Spring and Summer - frost and drought tolerant.	
	Eremophila maculata (red) Hardy shrub reaching 1.5m high - red tubular flowers much of the year - tolerant of drought and heavy soils – frost hardy.	
	Grevillea sp 'Amethyst' Bushy shrub to 1.5m - small linear pointed leaves – mauve pink flower clusters appear in Winter and continue into Spring - frost hardy.	

SHRUBS 1M-4M (cont'd)

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	<i>Grevillea arenaria</i> subsp. <i>canescens</i> Dense hardy rounded shrub to 1m tall - the soft oval leaves are a grey green colour - small glowing orange red flowers occur during Spring - frost hardy.	
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp 'Burgundy beauty' Fast growing screening shrub to 2m tall by 3m wide - light green fern like leaves - burgundy toothbrush flowers occur throughout the year – frost hardy.	
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp 'Flora mason' Fast growing shrub to 3m – divided grey green foliage – pink and yellow spider flowers in Winter and Spring – tolerates alkaline soil – moderately frost hardy.	
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp 'Hills jubilee' Compact shrub to 1m tall x 1m wide - small narrow linear leaves - clusters of waxy pink and white flowers throughout the year - tolerant of heavy clay – frost hardy.	
	<i>Hakea drupacea</i> 'Sweet-scented hakea' Dense rounded shrub growing up to 4m tall - needle-like leaves with sharp point - masses of fragrant white flowers in Autumn followed by woody seed capsules – hardy to salt winds and frosts.	
	<i>Lambertia formosa</i> 'Mountain devil' Upright vigorous shrub to 2m - reddish pointed narrow leaves - dark pink grevillea like flowers much of the year leading to unusual “devil head” seed pods - needs good drainage – hardy to moderate frosts.	
	<i>Leptospermum</i> sp 'Purple haze' Upright shrub to 1.5m x 1m - small oval green leaves - showy magenta tea tree flowers occur in Spring - may be clipped or hedged - frost hardy.	
	<i>Melaleuca lateritia</i> 'Robin redbreast bush' Erect and open shrub to 1.5m - soft linear green leaves - large outstanding orange brushes within the shrub in late Spring and Summer - frost hardy.	
	<i>Prostanthera phyllicifolia</i> 'Mt Norman mint bush' Erect bushy shrub to 1.5m - small dark green aromatic leaves - purple bell shaped flowers in Spring - frost hardy.	

LOW SHRUBS TO 1M AND GROUND COVERS

Plant image	Plant description	Number
	<i>Brachyscome</i> sp 'Amethyst' Small mounding groundcover, ideal for borders and pots – green divided leaves – brilliant magenta daisies are produced most of the year – moderate frost only.	
	<i>Correa</i> sp 'Kiss-me-Kate' Attractive spreading correa to 0.5m high - round olive-green leaves - masses of red bells during Summer and Autumn - frost hardy.	
	<i>Crowea</i> sp 'Poorinda ecstasy' Compact shrub to 1m x 1m - lime green aromatic foliage - bright pink star shaped flowers all year round - sun or part shade - frost hardy.	
	<i>Eremophila maculata</i> (purple) Rounded shrub to 1m - oval olive-green leaves - tubular purple flowers - tolerant of heavy soils and dry periods – frost hardy.	
	<i>Grevillea lanigera lutea</i> A spreading shrub reaching 0.3m high x 1.5m wide - soft narrow leaves - greenish yellow flowers in Spring - frost hardy.	
	<i>Grevillea</i> sp 'Pink pixie' A dwarf form of <i>G. rosmarinifolia</i> growing to 0.5m tall - narrow linear leaves - clusters of pink flowers in Spring – hardy to drought and frost.	
	<i>Melaleuca thymifolia</i> 'Pink lace' Attractive compact shrub to 50cm high - fine greyish foliage - delicate lacy pink flowers most of the year - frost hardy.	
	<i>Philotheca</i> sp 'Winter rouge' Neat, rounded shrub to 80cm high - aromatic green foliage - pink buds open to white waxy flowers in late Winter - frost hardy.	
	<i>Zieria prostrata</i> 'Carpet star' A compact prostrate plant spreading 50cm wide - trifoliate glossy green aromatic leaves - small starlike pink flowers during Spring - moderately frost hardy.
