- 3. Dogs must be on a leash and under control at all times.

- 5. Please allow space between dogs. When parading before the judges allow space between your dog and the dog in front.
- 6. You will receive a ticket for the prize draw for every class you enter your dog. Winners must be present, or prizes will be re-drawn until all prizes are claimed.
- 7. All children are to be accompanied by an adult in the competition area and while participating. Children under the age of 10 years are to be accompanied by an adult and the adult is to have full control of the dog.
