Gate admission fees apply on Friday & Saturday. Stanthorpe Agricultural Society members free.

SPECIAL NOTES

Entry fees: For direct deposit entry fees, proof of payment must be provided on delivery of cattle. If not paid by direct deposit, entry fees must be paid at the show office on or before Thu 2/2/23 (If entry fee has not been paid you will be ineligible for a prize).

Weighing: Weighing will commence approx. 12.30pm Thu 2/2/2023. Cattle requiring drafting after weighing must be in by 3pm. Cattle arriving after 4pm on Thu 2/2/23 will not be accepted for judging. Under no circumstances will cattle be reweighed.

Judging: All classes publicly judged in the Selling Ring, and ribbons presented as class is judged. Champion ribbons and trophies will be presented at approximately 11.00am on Fri 3/2/2023

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ALL CATTLE (including calves) TO BE NLIS TAGGED.
 2. Please remove all management tags prior to arrival.
 3. Exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor at least two months prior to the show.
 4. Separate exhibits in all classes.
 5. Registered stud cattle (incl. led steers) will not be eligible to compete in the Prime Cattle section.
 6. All cattle will be mouthed and considered to have teeth if teeth have erupted. Colour codes used to denote age of cattle as follows: Milk teeth-red; two teeth-white; four teeth-blue; six teeth-yellow; eight teeth-green.
 7. Stewards reserve the right to reject cattle which they consider to be of dangerous temperament or are not sufficient merit to compete as Prime Cattle and may place identification mark on cattle if necessary.
 8. Apart from Classes B1, B2 B6 & B7, all horns must be tipped and not to exceed the length of the ear. Fresh horn or castration wounds not allowed.
 9. Rejected cattle must be removed from the yards immediately.
 10. Steward may change a nominee's class if entered incorrectly.
 11. If the exhibits are of insufficient merit in any class, the judges may only award seconds
 12. At the Judge's discretion points may be awarded on a weight for age basis.
 13. Load out time – after 3pm Friday and then at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
 14. Normal animal husbandry requirements apply to animal health and disease recognition.
 15. All animals are to be in good health.
 16. Johne's disease specific requirements:
 - cattle must be minimum JBAS 6 status
 - cattle must be accompanied by a national health and a national vendor declaration
 - segregation of status 6 & 7
 - JBAS 8 cattle will not be accepted (we can not guarantee segregation)
 17. Refer to Livestock Biosecurity Network advice for show and exhibitors for further information.
 18. In the event of a suspected illness, animal is to be isolated and vet checked.
