TICKET SYSTEM ENTRY TO RING

RING OFFICE

The Ring Office is located alongside the Broadcast Box and is open from 7.30 am on Show days

SHOWDAY ONLINE

Whilst SHOWDAY ONLINE is now the predominant method of competition entry for the Stanthorpe Show, ring events will remain with the ticket entry system as described below. SHOWDAY ONLINE will display only the ring schedule. It is planned to introduce SHOWDAY ONLINE to the ring events for 2027.

TICKETS

- Ring completion tickets can be purchased from the Ring Office from 7.30 am onwards
- Tickets should be **completed in full** before entering a class. Incorrect entry tickets will forfeit competition
- Present tickets to a Ring Steward before judging commences
- NO REFUND ON TICKETS
- Dressage nominations are taken at the Ring Office

HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS

Horse health declarations are mandatory, and completed forms should be handed to the ring office staff before purchasing entry tickets, with PIC codes of origin & destination on HDDs.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

HORSE STALLS

- It is a requirement of the Stanthorpe Show Committee that Horse stalls must be used if available
- Stalls are \$10.00 per covered stall for the duration of the show
- Please indicate if you have Hacks, Ponies or Show Jumpers
- Stable Booking Forms should be completed and emailed to the Stable Steward at:
ring@stanagsociety.com.au
- Stable bookings are paid in advance. No refunds given
- Names and stable numbers will be attached to each stable prior to the show

HORSE MEASURING TIMES

- Horse measuring times are 7.30 am to 9.00 am Fri and Sat at measuring slab near exercise ring
- All horses and ponies in height classes are to have proof of measurement
- A *Measuring Certificate* from any Royal Show or Hack Council Queensland will be accepted

HELMETS

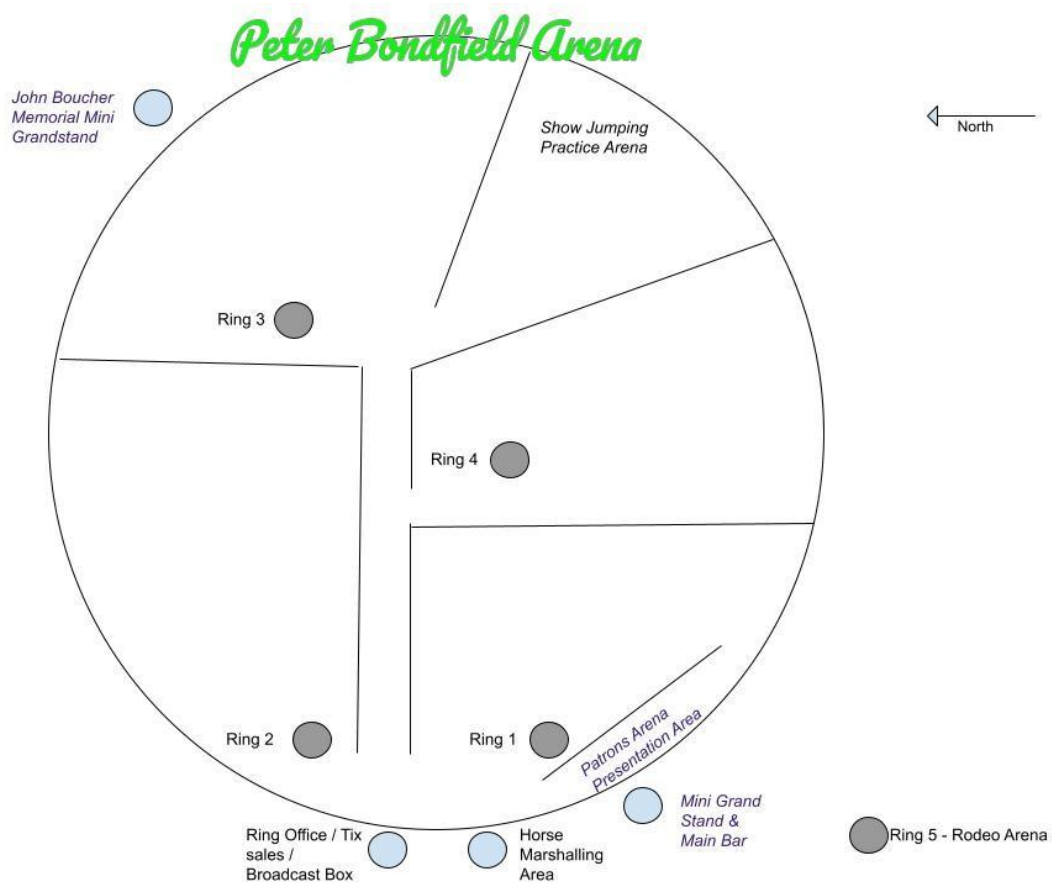
- All competitors are reminded that helmets are mandatory while riding on the showgrounds
- Helmets should be tagged when competing in any classes

MISCELLANEOUS

- All Competitors compete at the invitation of the Stanthorpe Show Society
- Prize money does not include GST
- Classes will not be delayed. Competitors must report to Marshalling/Ring Steward within three minutes of first call. In case of events clashing – competitor must decide
- Electric fences and temporary yards must be removed by 6.00am Friday and not re-erected during the show without prior permission from the Ringmaster
- Horse Health Declarations must be presented to the ring office prior to competition
- Waivers must be signed by all competitors prior to competition
- Dogs are not permitted in the Main Arena whilst horse events are in progress (assistance dogs excepted)
- Chief Ring Stewards reserve the right to change the program as necessary

HORSE REGULATIONS

1. *MAIDEN* has not won a first place whilst competing singly in any comparative event at an agricultural show
2. *NOVICE* has not won an open championship in any comparative event at an agricultural show.
3. *PONY HACKS* not exceeding 12.2h can be ridden by adults; however, it is the judge's discretion to decide if the pony is over-mounted
4. *SHOW HUNTER HACKS* are only permitted to compete in the open Hack, Galloway, Pony, OR the hunter classes. No colored browband or hair ribbons. Junior riders under 17 years are not permitted to wear top boots
5. *STALLIONS AND COLTS*, 2 years and over, are to be shown with a bit in their mouth or with a stallion chain. They must have green discs attached to their bridle or head stall. All stallion handlers are to be 17 years and over
6. *STALLIONS* may not compete in open hack Classes, only in classes provided
7. *LOCAL* is deemed to be anyone living full-time within 50 km of the Stanthorpe Showground
8. *PLEASURE CLASSES* are to be ridden in a snaffle bit. No whips or spurs permitted
9. *LEADING REIN* classes are for Ponies not over 12.2h, and riders under 8 years. Snaffle bit only, lead rein to be attached to the cavesson noseband. No spurs to be worn by the rider, and no whip to be carried. The handler must carry a cane
10. *BREED CLASS* exhibits must be registered with the appropriate society, and the exhibitors are to be current financial members. Random registration and membership checks may be undertaken at the discretion of the Stanthorpe Show Society
11. *RIDING BOOTS* should be heeled and soled with little or no tread, and be worn whilst riding within the confines of the Stanthorpe Showgrounds
12. *HELMETS* should be tagged and meet current Australian Standards and be worn whilst riding within the confines of the Stanthorpe Showgrounds
13. *PROTESTS* can be presented in writing to the Ring Office within ONE hour of the event, along with a \$50 deposit. Should the protest be considered frivolous by the disputes committee, the deposit will be forfeited
14. *JUDGES* decision is final
15. *EXHIBITS* behaving in an unruly or dangerous manner will be asked to leave the ring. Any person behaving in an unruly or dangerous manner will be asked to leave the Showgrounds. NO BULLYING POLICY
16. *DRUG TESTING* may be undertaken at the discretion of the Stanthorpe Show Society

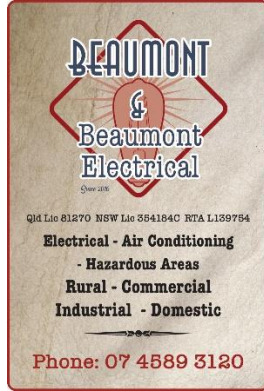

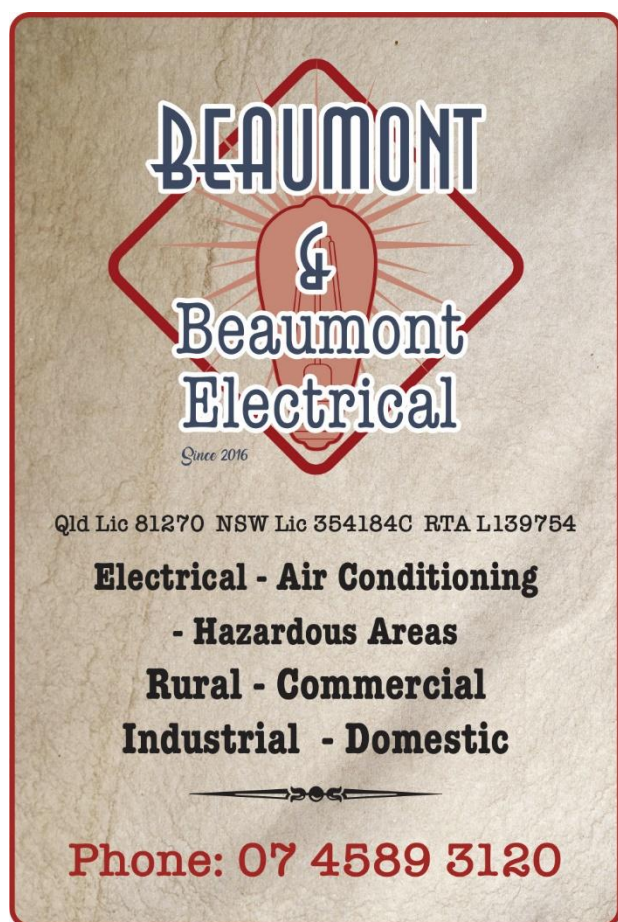
