



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SAFETY

- Competitors compete at their own risk subject to ACA and Stanthorpe Agricultural Society terms and conditions.
- While not compulsory, our committee encourages all riders to wear safety helmets while mounted.
- All riders under 18 years of age must wear an Australian Standard approved safety helmet whilst mounted in accordance with Rule B.5e of the ACA Rules.
- When worn, helmets must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules.

FOOD AND BAR

- The Stockman's Canteen will be operating throughout the weekend.
- The Stockman's Bar will be operating from noon to 11pm each day.

CAMPING

- Camping available with full amenities.

DOGS

- Stanthorpe Campdraft has a no dogs around horses or cattle policy. **NO DOGS AROUND CANTEEN OR CUT OUT YARD.** Please ensure your dogs are restrained and confined to your camp at all times.

HORSE HEALTH

- Competitors to ensure that their horse/s are of sound health and not showing any symptoms of illness or disease.
- In accordance with QCAS regulations for hosting the draft at a QCAS showgrounds, a completed horse health declaration (with PIC number) is required to be completed and submitted before your entry will be accepted.
- The procedure is:
 1. Download the horse health declaration from the Stanthorpe Campdraft or ACA website.
 2. Complete it in full and copy it. A PIC number for the property of origin is required.
 3. Keep one copy with you while your horses are travelling and place the second copy in the box outside the campdraft office before you compete.
- If required during the draft, the quarantine area for horses at the showgrounds is the sheep dog trials arena in the north-west corner of the grounds.

STATUS

Horse and/or rider may break status.

The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts.

The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (Rule 9.4).
