



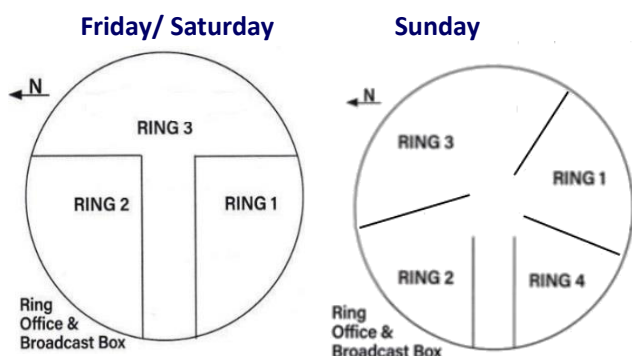

HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS All horse exhibitors must complete a horse health declaration and present to the ring office when purchasing entry tickets, with **PIC codes of origin & destination on HHD's**

HORSE STALLS Horse stalls must be used if available. They are available for **\$10.00 per covered stall for the duration of the show.** PLEASE INDICATE IF YOU ARE A HACK, SHOW JUMP or CHALLENGE COMPETITOR. **All stall bookings must be made on the stable booking form and emailed to:**

HORSE MEASURING TIMES All horses and ponies in height classes must be measured. Horse measuring times are 7.30am to 9.00am Friday and Saturday at measuring slab near exercise ring. A measuring certificate from any Royal Show or Hack Council Queensland will be accepted.

HELMETS All competitors are reminded that helmets must be worn in all classes and anytime while riding on the grounds. **Helmets must be tagged when competing in any EQ classes**
